TARSUS UNIVERSITY - AT A GLANCE

Tarsus University is a public institution accredited by the Council of Higher Education (YÖK) of Turkey and was established in 2018. Currently, it hosts 6,070 undergraduate, 491 master's, and 71 doctoral students, supported by 279 academic and 198 administrative and technical staff members. The university also welcomes 52 international students and 2 international staff members.

Since its establishment, Tarsus University has consistently prioritized the advancement of internationalization and research excellence. The university actively fosters interdisciplinary scientific collaboration, leading to a growing number of high-impact publications. In 2024 alone, 80 articles were published in internationally indexed journals (SCI, SCI-Expanded, SSCI, AHCI), all of which appeared in top-quartile journals (Q1–Q2). Since its inception, the university has produced a total of 620 Q1–Q2 publications, underscoring its commitment to high-quality research and global academic engagement.

Tarsus University holds the Erasmus Charter for Higher Education (ECHE) and has embraced international mobility as a core institutional value. Despite the challenges posed by the COVID-19 pandemic, the university has signed 68 Erasmus Agreements and has actively participated in staff and student mobility under Erasmus+ Key Actions KA131, KA171, KA130 (consortium), and KA203, both within and beyond Europe since 2019.

The university's international office continues to broaden its global engagement through large-scale EU-funded projects. Notably, the SUNGATE project (HORIZON-CL5-2022-D3-03) was granted €4,897,007, and the INTACT project (H2020-MSCA-RISE-2020) received €1,357,000 in funding. These initiatives further consolidate Tarsus University's position as an emerging player in international research and innovation networks.
